

Basic informations about the First European Ural Meeting

Time:

Friday 5th until Sunday 7th of September 2008

Location: Castle Schauberg near Eferding, Upper Austria

The meeting will take place in the inner courtyards of a medieval castle. The whole ensemble is heritage-protected. Of the castle only some walls and half of the donjon are left. We have already held some small meetings in this romantic ambience. Unfortunately there is no infrastructure for catering and accomodation or even something luxury available. But we will of course take care of the catering. As an exception we are allowed to drive into the castle with our sidecars. But of course everyone should take care that there are no damages inside.

Camping

There is not enough space inside the castle to camp. Therefore we are building up a camping place at the foot of the castle, on the meadow of a "Mostbauer" (this is a farmer in Austria who produces an alcoholic apple cider).

The camping ground is about 3 minutes per bike and about 15 minutes per foot away from the castle.

In the evening we will have a shuttle service between the castle and the camping ground, of course in authentic style, with a Ural Trike.

Roadbook-Rallye:

The highlight of the meeting will be the Roadbook Rallye on Saturday
The tour is about 150 km long and leads through the northern part of Austria, called "Mühlviertel". The region "Mühlviertel" is a manifold countryside. We have chosen a route which gives us beautiful looks inside and outside of the country. On the checkpoints there are points to gather. The checkpoints will also be at medieval castles.

Of course there will be enough off-road tracks. Partially not easy. But for every trained Ural driver achievable.

Saturday evening we will have the awards together with barbeque, campfire and live music.

The awards are of total value of about EURO 4.000,00. All participants will get an award. The awards will be dedicated from our spare parts stock and therefore useful for each Ural driver. The main award will be a Ural trailer together with the tow-bar for a Ural sidecar. Consolation prize will be an oil filter.
